

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

Enterprise Plants provides Interior landscaping, Grounds maintenance services and contract floral arrangements for corporate clients.

We are committed reducing the environmental impacts associated with our operations whilst preventing pollution. We will achieve this commitment by implementing the following environmental objectives:

- Develop our no peat policy to 100% no new peat usage.
- We acknowledge the **Waste Hierarchy** and have systems in place to promote this and communicate it within our company.
Prevention: We aim to encourage our suppliers to reduce packaging and to also re use what we can thereby extending the life of certain items where reasonable.
Re- Use: We will ensure that where possible, goods are re used, repaired and maintained to ensure a long service life and that goods bought in will be considered for ease of maintenance and upgrade.
Recycle: We aim to separate and recycle as much as is possible and will look to turn waste into new substances or products where viable.
Disposal: We aim to use "Disposal" as a last resort and strive to dispose of waste materials in such a way as not to cause harm to the environment.
- We use only environmentally friendly fertilisers and herbicides responsibly and keep usage of both down to a minimum.
- Ensure that our drivers drive their vehicles efficiently, reduce trips where possible and ensure vehicles are regularly serviced to keep emissions to a minimum. Always consider the most environmentally friendly vehicles when replacing vehicles and regularly monitor fuel usage
- Ensure that energy generated from fossil fuels is used efficiently. Reduce our carbon footprint by reducing energy usage from fossil fuels by using "Green" power sources wherever possible.
- To ensure that all wood is obtained from sustainable sources unless operational requirements dictate otherwise.
- We seek to raise awareness of our environmental procedures and targets among our suppliers and sub contractors and ensure they adhere to our Environmental policies.
- We work in partnership with the community by behaving in a considerate and socially responsible manner with regard to natural habitats and the environment in general.
- We manage effective incident control by investigation, reporting, monitoring and review.
- All managerial staff should be aware of their responsibilities for the implementation of this policy and communicate changes to their department members.
- Enterprise Plants will fully comply with all legal requirements and standards set out in the standards for ISO 14001: 2004
- All employees will be provided with the necessary resources, equipment, information, instruction and training to fulfil the requirements of this policy.
