



ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

Enterprise Plants provides interior landscaping, grounds maintenance services, food waste collection and recycling services and contract floral arrangements for corporate clients.

We are committed reducing the environmental impacts associated with our operations whilst preventing pollution. We will achieve this commitment by implementing the following environmental objectives:

- Develop our no peat policy to 100% no new peat usage
- Dispose of waste in a responsible manner; recycling our own and our clients waste where possible and abiding by any current legislation
- Only use environmentally friendly fertilisers and herbicides responsibly and keep usage of both down to a minimum.
- Ensure that our drivers drive their vehicles efficiently, reduce trips where possible and ensure vehicles are regularly serviced to keep emissions to a minimum. Always consider the most environmentally friendly vehicles when replacing vehicles and regularly monitor fuel usage
- Ensuring that energy generated from fossil fuels is used efficiently. Reduce our carbon footprint by reducing energy usage from fossil fuels by using "Green" power sources wherever possible.
- To ensure that all wood is obtained from sustainable sources unless operational requirements dictate otherwise.
- Raising awareness of our environmental procedures and targets amongst our suppliers and sub contractors and ensuring they abide by our Environmental policies.
- Seeking to work in partnership with the community by behaving in a considerate and socially responsible manner with regard to natural habitats and the environment in general
- Ensuring effective incident control, investigation and reporting.
- All managerial staff should be aware of their responsibilities for the implementation of this policy.
- Enterprise Plants will fully comply with all legal requirements and standards set out in iso 14001
- All employees will be provided with the necessary resources, equipment, information, instruction and training to fulfil the requirements of this policy.
